
ABOUT THE AUTHOR



In its present form, The Helianx Proposition unifies three stages of expression. The original story can be read in the calligraphic text, illuminated by the images that emerged over three decades of intuitive work. On your second reading, slow down even more and let the written work resonate with the dream forms and colors. Eventually, when you feel you know the tale well and have soaked a while in its pool, start to add the third and final layer of the text on the facing pages. 
